Celebration of Fiber Arts at Mistlin Gallery ...

CCQ will again mount an all-textile show at Mistlin Gallery April 2 - May 3 at 1015 J Street in Modesto. This will be our first show there since 2018, thanks to Covid and related scheduling difficulties. All types of textiles will be accepted for display, including wall and lap quilts (bed size quilts are too large for the available space) and wearables. The entries will NOT be for sale, a departure from prior years. Entry forms are available on the CCQ website, at guild meetings and from Sue Siefkin. Entry forms must be submitted by March 4th, with a color photo to be emailed to Joyce Compton (comptonjoyce@sbcglobal.net). Entries will be returned to the makers in time for delivery to the CCQ quilt show in May. CCQ's Opportunity Quilt will be on display; volunteers are needed to sell raffle tickets in the gallery. Small 6 x 8" mini art quilts will be matted and sold during the exhibit; members are invited to make and deliver them to Sue Siefkin for mounting. Edges need not be bound, just straight stitched or zig zag. The gallery will receive 25% of the \$40 sales price; makers will be paid the balance. Questions? CCQ Best Sellers Challenge

Pick the title of any book (you need not have read it) and make a quilt inspired solely by the title. How about house blocks for Little House on the Prairie, the Storm at Sea pattern for The Old Man and the Sea, or an appliqué of your own design? The title of the book need NOT be on the face of the quilt. You choose the shape, as long as the quilt perimeter does not exceed 100 inches. Your entries will need a split sleeve and a hanging rod to be hung from a D-ring in the middle. Stumped on what to choose and make?
