# GETTING YOUR QUILTS READY !

#### Ready, Set Go!

Here are a few helpful hints on how to get your quilts ready for the Shew.

- Take a picture of your quilt and email it to Lois Logsdon (LoisAndSyd@gmail.com) Lois and Syd Longsdon are the two wonderful people that decide where each quilt is going to hang within the quilt show. The two pieces of information that they need is a picture of your quilt and the measurements.
- Fill out the Quilt Show Entry Form and the Display Card Information and mail it to Ann Sweet (CCQ c/o Ann Sweet 1316 Amy Ave. Modesto 95357). Ann is going to keep track of your quilt, and she types up that cute little card that goes next to your quilt.
- 3). Make sure you have a 4" Sleeve on the back of your quilt for hanging. If you don't know how to make a 4" sleeve for your quilt, ask someone!
- 4). Fill out the Label and hand stitch it to the lower right corner of your quilt back.
- 5). Fill out the **Receipt** and put it in your purse or pin it to your quilt so it is handy. You will need it when you deliver and pick up your quilt.



# Clue #3:

#### ROWS:

Layout the blocks in a 5 x 4 grid (5 blocks across and 4 rows), alternating the direction of the blocks until you are happy with the distribution of the fabrics.




Rows 2 and 4

Strip piece  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF **Background** strips to the right side the first (4) blocks in each of the (3) rows. Pay attention to the direction of the blocks. Press toward the **Background** fabric and trim to  $7\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " sashed blocks



Sew (4) sashed blocks and (1) unsashed block together. Press toward the Sashing fabric. Make (4 rows).
