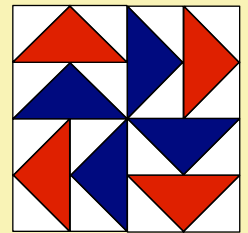


Quick Method Flying Geese for Dutchman's Puzzle

12" Block

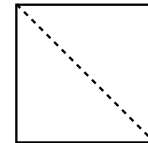
Makes 1 Block



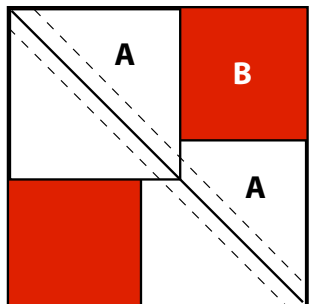
- A** Cut 8 4" squares of White fabric
- B** Cut 1 7 3/8" square of Red fabric
- B** Cut 1 7 3/8" square of Blue fabric

For Flying Geese, take all **A** 4" White squares and draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on back of fabric.

Place two White squares face down on top of the **B** 7 3/8" Red or Blue, positioned on opposite corners:

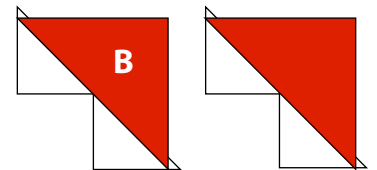


Pin B to A, if they are shifting around.

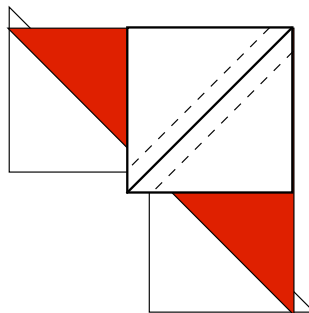


Sew 1/4" on either side of diagonal lines.

Cut apart and press as shown with seams toward **B**.



Makes two units.

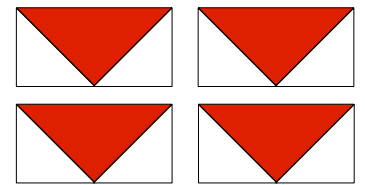


Lay one **A** White square on corner of each unit, and sew 1/4" on either side of line.

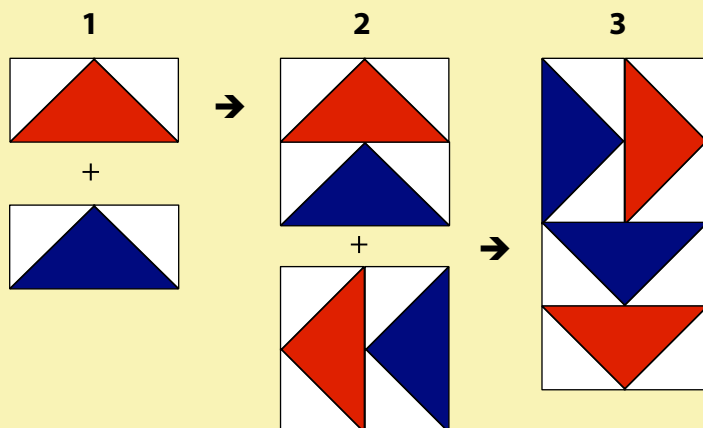
Cut apart and press. Trim dog ears and square to 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" units.

TRIM from the WIDE side of the triangle so that 1/4" seam is intact to make sharp points when units are sewn together.

Repeat with Blue B fabric to make four additional units.



Makes four Flying Geese.



Next, sew like a 4-patch using four sets of Flying Geese units, sewn together as shown. Finished size is 12 1/2"
